Erasmus+ Mobility & Application Process

Vitae Escola Universitària de l'Esport i la Salut will be participating in the Erasmus+ Programme, offering mobility opportunities for both study and traineeships.

Study Mobility

Students may undertake a study period abroad at a partner higher education institution.

- Duration: one or two semesters
- Workload: 30 ECTS per semester

Traineeship Mobility

Students may complete traineeships in companies, organizations or institutions abroad.

- Duration: 2 to 12 months

Nomination Process

Partner institutions are invited to nominate their students for Erasmus+ mobility by contacting the Office of Global Affairs (OGA) by email: oga@escolavitae.com. Nomination deadlines will be communicated annually to partner institutions.

Application Process

Nominated students will be required to submit an application to Vitae Escola Universitària de l'Esport i la Salut.

Detailed application procedures and deadlines will be communicated upon nomination.
